# COST

**Enrolment: £40** covering DofE costs for pupils and school Provider fee.

**Expedition costs: £40 each = £80** This covers coaches to start of route ; Camping fees; Equipment – tents, rucksacks, cooking stoves; School staff cover costs (8 teachers being covered to attend DofE), reimbursement of petrol costs and Assessor fees.

**Total cost = £120**

FSM / Financial difficulties – support from the DoE pot – Please do not let financial concerns prevent your child from taking part.

Payment: The finance office will directly contact parents to arrange for payment to be made through Parent Pay.


